

## SUBSTANCE USE

Many studies have focused on drinking behaviours in First Responders (Davey, Obst, & Sheenan, 2001 Bacharach, Bamberger, & Doveh, 2008; Ballenger et al., 2010; Fieldheim et al., 2014). Substance use in First Responders have not received as much focused. There have been, however, a large link between other struggles (e.g. PTSD) and substance use (Brady & Sinha, 2005; van Dam, Vedel Ehring & Emmelkamp, 2012).



**Experimenting** Using the substance a few times, out of curiosity

Recreation Use is social, but still made consciously

Regular Use is no longer an action of opportunity

Dependant Use is now more ingrained. No longer an action of opportunity

The Substance Use Model is applicable to all substances and not specific to any single problem substance use.
